

# REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

## Procurement Specialist

The International Sava River Basin Commission (ISRBC) has received financing, by signing the Grant Agreement with the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (World Bank), which acts as an implementing agency of the Global Environment Facility (GEF), for the GEF Sava and Drina Rivers Corridors Integrated Development Program (SDIP), toward the cost of the implementation of the Component 4 - Regional Activities of the SDIP, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services by hiring a Procurement Specialist to ensure the execution of procurement of goods and services during the implementation of Component 4 of the Project.

The ISRBC now invites individual consultants to express their interest in providing the aforementioned services. Candidates who wish to apply for the position must meet the following mandatory requirements: (i) A minimum level of education corresponding to completed university studies of at least 4 years attested by a diploma (equivalent to 300 ECTS) with major in economics, business, law or engineering; (ii) a minimum of seven (7) years of professional experience relevant for post; (iii) Excellent command of both written and spoken English and one of the official languages of the ISRBC; (iv) Valid driving license/B category.

The Procurement Specialist shall in principle work in the premises of the ISRBC Secretariat in Zagreb (Croatia), with occasional short trips to support the implementation of the Project, as needed.

The Procurement Specialist will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out of in the *World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers – Procurement in Investment Project Financing Goods, World, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services, July 2016, revised August 2018 and November 2020 (“the Regulations”)*. The attention of interested candidates is drawn to paragraph 3.16 and 3.17 of the Regulations, setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
